
Risks & Outcomes

Youth learn about the dangers and effects of substances like alcohol, marijuana, synthetic drugs, prescription drugs, and meth, as well as individual susceptibility to addiction.

Making Choices
Youth learn the difference between low risk and high risk choices and of the impact their decisions have on their lives.

Awareness & Self-Efficacy

Through guided discussion, youth identify their values and sparks. Working through "what would you do" scenarios, youth practice protecting things that matter most.
